

BALLISTIPAX FIREARMS PURCHASE AND TRANSFER POLICY

FIREARMS PURCHASE DISCLAIMER

- Please read all information listed on our web site, www.Ballistipax.com, before purchasing a firearm from Ballistipax LLC.
- Please ask all questions before placing a firearms order.
- Buyer certifies that by purchasing a firearm from Ballistipax LLC that Buyer is legally qualified to purchase and own a firearm and that there are no federal, state, or local laws preventing Buyer's purchase or ownership of a firearm. Furthermore, it is the Buyer's responsibility to check with their designated recipient Federal Firearms License ("FFL") dealer on legal requirements in the Buyer's jurisdiction.
- If the Buyer is denied possession of the firearm for any reason, and the item must be returned to Ballistipax LLC, there will be a restocking fee and shipping charges applied. Any deposits are non-refundable. There is a 35% restocking fee on approved returns.
- Buyer understands that all firearms are potentially dangerous if handled improperly. Upon purchase, Buyer assumes all liability and responsibility including but not limited to the use, security, and safe storage of the firearm purchased. Buyer will utilize a trigger lock to prevent accidents.
- Ballistipax LLC has no firearm testing facility and Ballistipax LLC assumes no liability for the safe functioning of any firearm sold. All firearms are sold "as is" and all firearm warranty issues are the responsibility of the original firearm manufacturer; specifically, Ballistipax LLC does not warranty firearms.



FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSE DISCLAIMER

In accordance with The Gun Control Act of 1968, Ballistipax LLC does not sell firearms directly to the end-user. All sales of firearms must go through a Federal Firearms License ("FFL") dealer which is a business or individual with a Federal Firearms License. FFL dealers have been approved by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives ("ATF") to do background checks and take all the other necessary steps to legally transfer firearms to individuals. Any firearm being shipped to an individual must be shipped to an FFL dealer so that its transfer can be processed in accordance with all federal, state, and local regulations.

OTHER SHIPPING INFORMATION

- Shipping charges will be calculated at the time of purchase.
- Ballistipax LLC is not responsible for uninsured items lost or damaged in transit. If you would like insurance added to your order, please contact us.
- Firearms normally ship within 5 business days after receipt of payment and receipt of a valid copy of the recipient FFL dealer's ATF Form 8.

SHIPPING A FIREARM AND TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

- Ballistipax LLC will transfer ownership of any firearm only to individuals or agencies in possession of a valid FFL.
- Ballistipax does NOT ship to PO Boxes.
- Ballistipax LLC is required by the ATF to have a physical copy of the recipient FFL dealer's license (ATF Form 8) before Ballistipax LLC can ship the firearm to the recipient FFL dealer.
- It is the Buyer's responsibility to identify and contact the recipient FFL dealer to whom the firearm is to be shipped and it is the Buyer's responsibility to ensure that a valid copy of the recipient FFL dealer ATF Form 8 and all pertinent contact information is received by Ballistipax LLC. If the Buyer has never dealt with an FFL dealer, the Buyer will want to contact a local FFL first to ensure they are willing to perform transfers and find out their transfer fees and schedules. Ballistipax LLC will also accept FFL ATF Form 8 via email: FFL@Ballistipax.com

- Upon receipt of the ATF Form 8 from the recipient FFL dealer, the firearm will be ready to ship.
- The Buyer will automatically receive a copy of the shipping information/tracking number by email.
- It is the Buyer's responsibility to coordinate with the recipient FFL dealer to receive the firearm.
- Prior to completing the transfer of ownership of the firearm, inspect it to ensure the condition is acceptable. Once the firearm ownership is transferred, it becomes the Buyer's responsibility to contact the manufacturer if there are any defects or warranty issues.
- By purchasing a firearm from Ballistipax LLC, the Buyer acknowledges that the recipient FFL dealer may charge a transaction fee and that this transfer fee is strictly between the Buyer and the recipient FFL dealer.
